### BCQG Block of the Month

### February 2015 – Block #4

Unfinished Block Size: 14-½" x 14-½"

Finished Block Size: 14" x 14"

#### Supplies:

15-½" x 15-½" Background Fabric is cut larger to accommodate for applique shrinkage (It will be trimmed to 14-½" x 14-½")

Assorted Fabric Scraps:

Light Blue for Letters

Green for Leaves

Brown for Vines

Print for Scarf and Hat and Coordinating Fabric for Hat Trim

Orange for Nose

Red Print for Heart

Embroidery thread or Floss (used 2 strands) for eyes

#### Directions:

Trace the applique pieces using the templates onto paper-backed Fusible Web (Heat and Bond Light was used). Or use your favorite applique method (e.g., needle turned, raw edge, freezer paper, etc.). **Please note that pattern pieces are reversed for using with paper-back Fusible Web.** Following the manufacturer instructions, apply the paper-backed Fusible Web onto the wrong side of each fabric. Cut on the drawn line.

Place the prepared applique pieces onto the 15-½" x 15-½" background fabric following the diagram. Ensure that pieces fit within a 13-inch square.

Stitch applique edges using your favorite decorative stitch or straight stitch works well also.

Embroider the Snowman eyes with floss using French Knott stitch.

Square the Block to 14-½ x 14-½ inches.
