

## 4 Patch Sashing Blocks

#### September 2015 – Block # 11

MAKE 2 Blue (12-½" x 4-½")

MAKE 1 Red (16-½" x 4-½")

Unfinished Block Size: 12-½" x 4-½" and  
16-½" x 4-½"

Finished Block Size: 12" x 4" and  
16" x 4"



#### Supplies:

¼ Yard of Light Print Fabric

¼ Yard of Dark Print Fabric

#### Directions:

Cut two 2-½" strips of the light fabric.

Cut two 2-½" strips of the dark fabric.

With right sides together, sew one light strip of fabric to one dark strip using a ¼" seam allowance.

Press seam allowance towards the dark strip.

Repeat with other 2 strips.

Place one strip set on your cutting mat, right side facing up. Place the second strip set over the first set with the second set right side facing down. Nest the seams together. Cut the strip sets into 2 ½" sections.

Keeping the pairs together just as you cut them, sew the pairs together with a ¼" seam allowance, continuing until all the pairs are sewn together into four patches.

Square blocks to 4-½".

#### Assembling 3 Sashing Blocks:

Make one block with 3 patches sewn together in a row.

Make two blocks with 4 patches sewn together in a row.
