BCQG Block of the Month

June 2015 – Block #8

Unfinished Block Size: 16- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16- $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Supplies:

1 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Square of white fabric for snowman face

1 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Square of Black fabric for snowman face

Use the template to trace and cut white and black fabric squares as shown

Note: Alternately you may use a fussy-cut 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square for the center of the log cabin block

8 Dark Blue Fat-Eighths for the Logs

8 Light Blue Fat-Eighths for the Logs

Directions:

Cut one strip from each the dark blue fat-eighths.

Two (2) 6"x2" Strips

Two (2) 9"x2" Strips

Two (2) 12"x2" Strips

Two (2) 15- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x2" Strips

Cut one strip from each of the light blue fat-eighths

One (1) 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x2" Strip

Two (2) 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x2" Strips

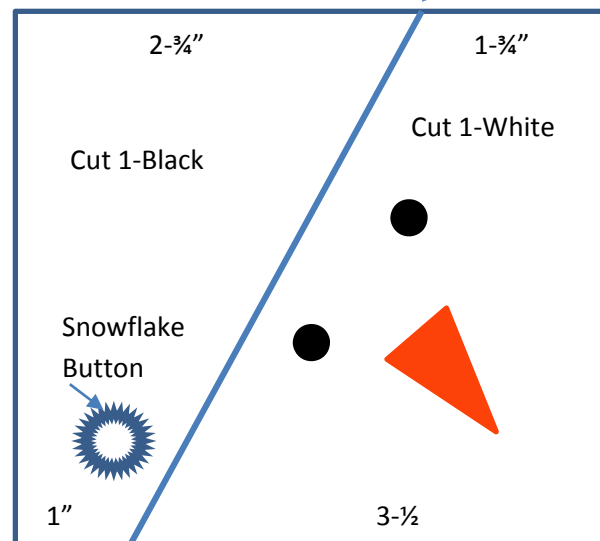
Two (2) 10- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x2" Strips

Two (2) 13- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x2" Strips

Two (2) 16- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x2" Strips



Cut along this line and add $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to each piece



Prepare and finish the center block, square to 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Take the "Center" square and sew the 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x2 light blue strip to the top of the center square. Next sew one dark blue 6"x2" strip to the right side of the block. Continue adding strips clockwise following the log cabin dark and light scheme (darks are to the right and bottom of the block and lights are to the left and top of the block). Embroider eyes and nose or use buttons as shown. Square block to 16- $\frac{1}{2}$ "x16- $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
