

Tree Block

Unfinished Block Size: 4-½" x 20-½"

Finished Block Size: 4" x 20"

Supplies:

From Background cut:

(2) 2-½" x wof (width of fabric) Strip, from this cut the following:

(8) 2-½" Squares (draw a diagonal line on the wrong side)

(8) 1-½" Squares (draw a diagonal line on the wrong side)

(4) 1-½" x 4-½" (for sashing)

(2) 2" x 6" Rectangles

Green Fabric:

(4) 2-½" x 4-½" for Tree Tops

(4) 1-½" x 4-½" for Tree Middle Layers

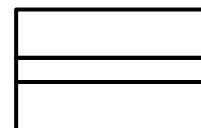
Brown Fabric:

(1) 1-½" x 6" Strip for Tree Trunk

Directions:

Sew (1) 2" x 6" background rectangles to the top and bottom of the 1-½" x 6" trunk fabric.

Cut into (4) pieces 1 ½" x 4-½", this is the bottom row of your tree.



Top of tree, place (1) 2-½" background square on left side of (1) 2-½" x 4-½" green rectangle, with right sides together, and stitch on the diagonal line. Press open. Repeat on right side. Trim off excess of ¼" seam allowance on the wrong side. Make 4.

Middle of tree, place (1) 1-½" background square on left side of (1) 1-½" x 4-½" green rectangle, right sides together and stitch on the diagonal. Press open. Repeat on the right side. Trim off excess of ¼" seam allowance on the wrong side. MAKE 4.

Layer top, middle, and bottom of tree, and sew together. Square block to 4-½". Make 4.

Attach a sashing piece in between each tree block and on the right side of the last tree block. Block should measure 4-½" high x 20-½" wide.
