

**Scrappy Happy House**  
**BCQG Block of the Month**  
**March 2015 – Block #5**

Unfinished Block Size: 16-½" x 14-½"

Finished Block Size: 16" x 14"

**Supplies:**

17-½" x 15-½" Background Fabric (It will be trimmed to 16-½" x 14-½")

Assorted Fabric Scraps for applique pieces:

Greens for Tree

Brown for Trunk

Yellow/Gold for Windows

White for Snow

Red for Door

Chimney Fabric

Roof Fabric

White Embroidery Thread or Floss (used 2 strands)

**Directions:**

Trace the applique pieces using the templates onto paper-backed Fusible Web (Heat and Bond Light was used). Or use your favorite applique method (e.g., needle turned, raw edge, freezer paper, etc.). **Please note that pattern pieces are reversed for using with paper-back Fusible Web.** Following the manufacturer instructions, apply the paper-backed Fusible Web onto the wrong side of each fabric. Cut on the drawn line.

Place the prepared applique pieces onto the 17-½" x 15-½" background fabric following the diagram.

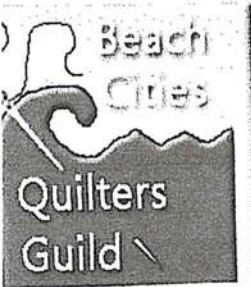
Ensure that the applique design fits within a 15-½" x 13-½" area.

Stitch applique edges using your favorite decorative stitch or straight stitch works well also.

Embroider the chimney "smoke" with white thread/floss using backstitch.

Trim the Block to 16-½ x 14-½ inches.

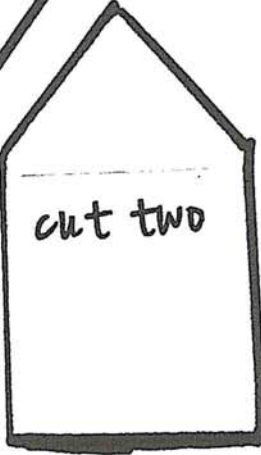




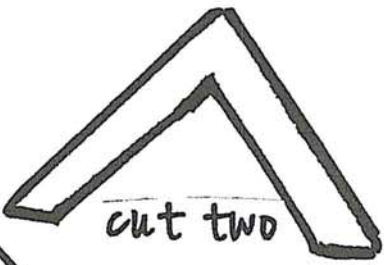

16 x 14 finished

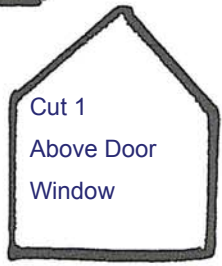
pattern is reversed for fusible



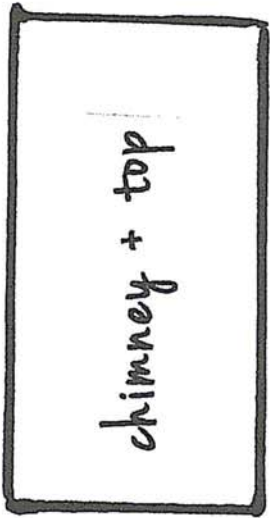
cut two

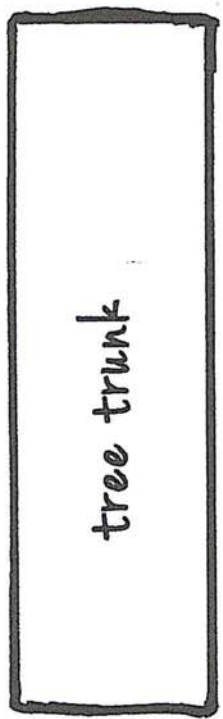
Cut 1

Window



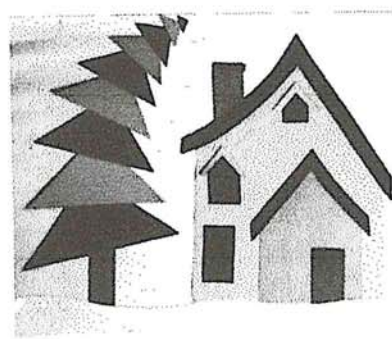
chimney + top

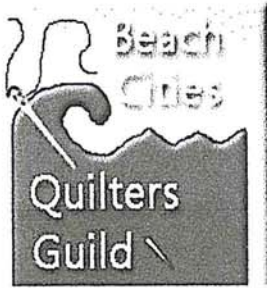


cut two

window



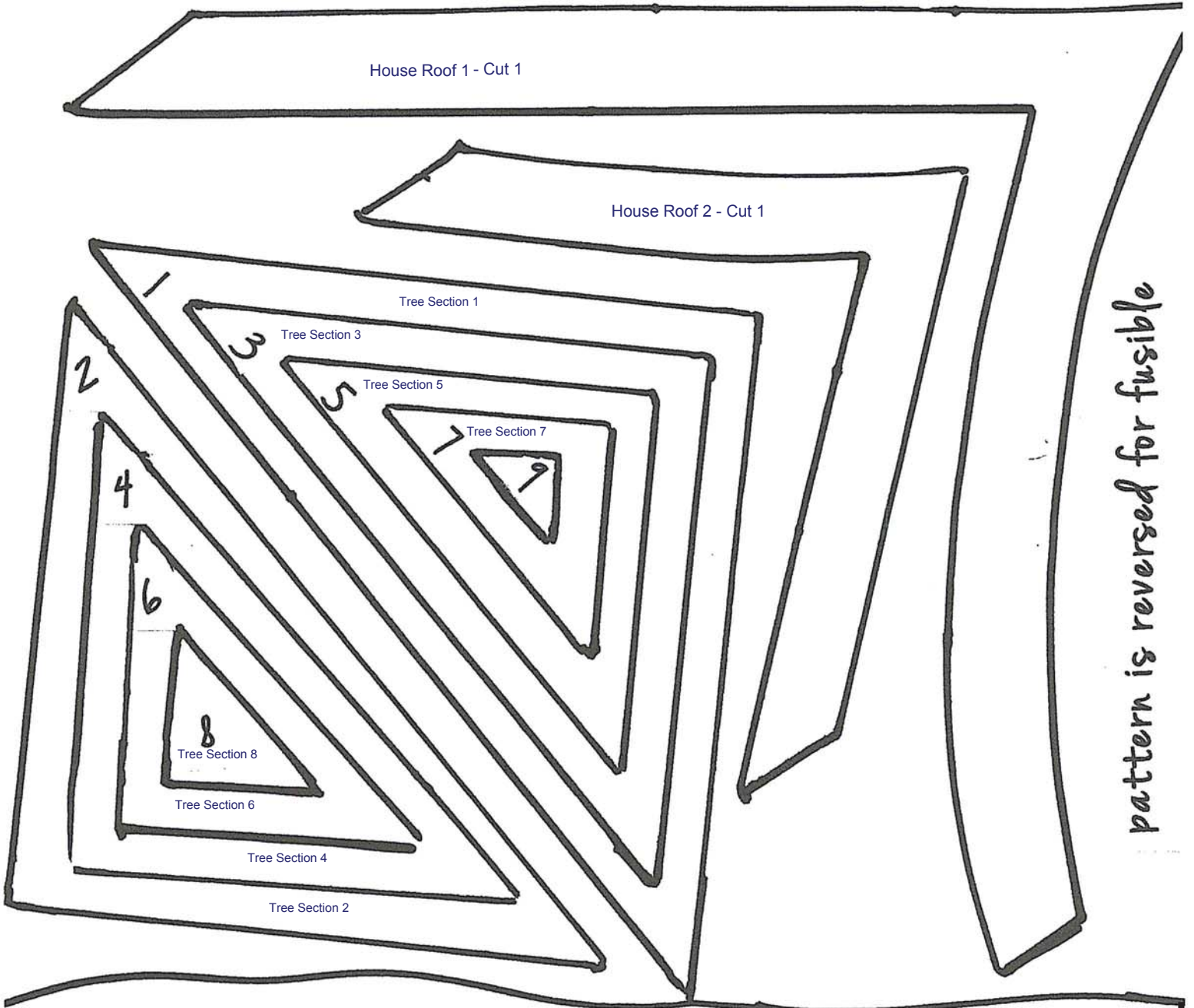
tree trunk
