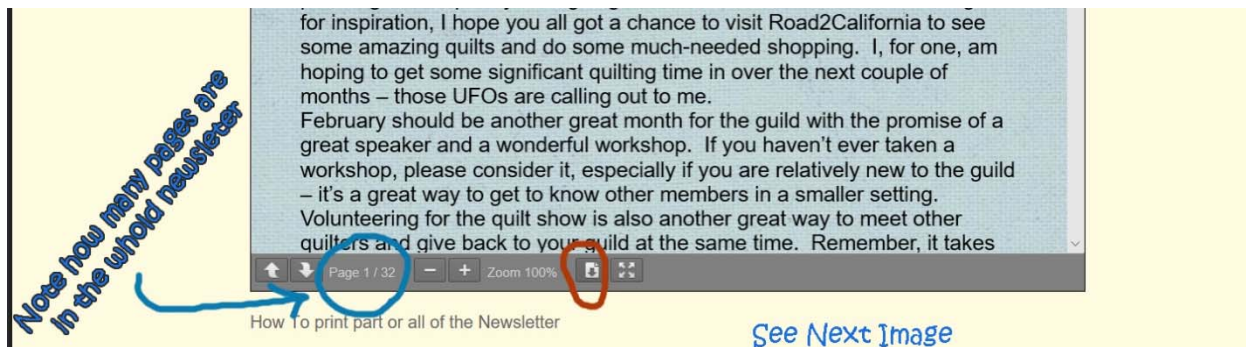


Printing All or Part of the BCQG Newsletter
